


## How to access the InvestorPortal with VP-ID

The first time you log on to the Investorportal there are two steps:

1. Order an activation code
2. Use the activation code to create your VP-ID

### First time at the InvestorPortal:



Be aware that the same VP-ID can be used for all companies.





## When you have received your activation code:






Choose if you want to use CPR/CVR-number or VP-reference number.

Enter CPR/CVR-number or VP-reference number and activation code.

Choose a unique username and password.

The Password need to be at least 8th characters long containing both letter and numbers.

Click 'Create'
